

FOOTBALL NORTHERN TERRITORY REGISTRATION Terms and Conditions

Players "Member" refers to a MiniRoos, junior or senior football player.

Note: All players must be registered via the National Online Registration System known as PlayFootball. The registration of a Player with a Club is effective from the date the individual is made 'active' by the Club within the National Online Registration System.

The registration can be completed through:

1. The Player self-registering via PlayFootball; or
2. In exceptional circumstances, the Player completing the prescribed registration form and the Club registering the Player on the Player's behalf via PlayFootball.

If a Player is registering for the first time, that Player must provide the Club with evidence of identity and age (e.g., original birth certificate, passport, or driver's licence). The registration of a Player with their Club continues for a Season and ends on the later of the end of the Season or the time as specified in the FNT Rules of Competition, unless terminated earlier in accordance with the Football Australia National Registration Regulations.

By registering with Football NT using the National Registration System (PlayFootball) you (the Member) (or, if the Member is under 18 years of age, the Member's parent or legal guardian and the Member):

1. Warrant that the information provided is current and correct;
2. Warrant that the Member holds only one PlayFootball account;
3. Agree to comply with the Football Northern Territory Rules and Regulations and Football Australia Rules and Regulations (as defined in the FNT Rules of Competition) in relation to dual registration;
4. Agree to comply with the Football Northern Territory Policies, Procedures and Regulations and Football Australia Rules and Regulations, including, but not limited to:
 - Football Northern Territory By-Laws;
 - Football Australia Grievance and Disciplinary Regulations;
 - FNT Member Protection Framework;
 - Football Northern Territory Social Media Policy;
 - FNT Safeguarding Children Policy; and
 - Applicable Football Northern Territory Competition Regulations;
5. Acknowledge that the Member must be registered to serve any fixture suspension;
6. Acknowledge and agree that a failure by you (or your parent/guardian) to comply with the Football Northern Territory Rules and Regulations and Football Australia Rules and Regulations (including the FA Spectator Code of Behaviour and FNT Code of Conduct & Ethics) may result in sanctions (including bans from attendance, suspension, or de-registration);
7. Agree to submit exclusively to the jurisdiction of the FNT Grievance & Disciplinary Regulations and Football Australia Statutes (including the Grievance Procedure By-Law) and agree not to attempt to resolve any Grievance in a court of law.
