

IMPORTANT NOTICE TO ALL REGISTERED PARTICIPANTS

Dear Football Community,

Nominations are now open for Zone Councillors in the Southern, Central and Northern Zones.

Why this matters

Zone Councils are how participants in each part of the Territory have a direct say in how your game is run. Three members of each Zone Council also become voting Members of Football Northern Territory, which means they vote at General Meetings and on the election of Directors. If you want football run in a way that reflects your region, this is where that starts.

What is involved

Each Zone Council has between 6 and 10 Councillors, elected for a two-year term. Councils meet regularly through the year, and can meet by phone or video, so you do not need to be in a particular town to take part.

Who can stand

Anyone aged 18 or over can stand, provided they are nominated. A nomination can come from a Club, or from two people who are eligible to vote in that Zone. Registered participants are eligible to vote in their own Zone, and where a participant is under 18 their parent or guardian votes for them.

How to nominate

Please read carefully the attached [Notice Calling for Nominations](#) which provides additional information and then complete the [Nomination Zone Councillor](#) form. Please read both these documents carefully as we cannot accept nominations that aren't compliant with the current Football Northern Territory Incorporated Constitution.

What happens next

If there are fewer or the same number of candidates as positions, those candidates are elected and we will announce the result. If there are more candidates than positions, we will hold a ballot and every eligible participant in that Zone will get to vote. Either way we will let you know.
